A showcase competition for up-and-coming dogs under the age of three

The Rose City Future Star Spectacular is a showcase for this generation's most promising up-and-coming show dogs – those that take our breath away and fill our heads with dreams of winning Best-in-Show. The Spectacular is for dogs that are more than worthy champions. It's for standouts, for dogs that have that special quality some call the "it factor."

Eligibility

Mandatory for all entrants: Dogs must be under the age of 3-years old to participate. The day a dog turns 3 s/he loses eligibility. A dog that turns 3 on January 22, is ineligible. There are no requirements for who must handle the entrant. There are three basic ways to qualify:

- The top winning dog under 3 from any of the specialties
- The top winning dog at any 2 of the 3 preceding RCC all-breed shows
- Any dog under 3 that is listed in the top 20 of its breed in the most recent Canine Chronicle in the breed or All-breed

Note: A dog does not necessarily have to win the breed at one of the applicable shows to qualify. If a dog that is 3 or older wins the breed, then the dog that wins the next highest award that is under 3-years of age would qualify, for instance, Best Opposite, Select to Best of Breed, or even Best of Winners.

The Future Star Spectacular will be held Sunday during the lunch hour in a designated ring. It will be judged by respected, long-time purebred dog experts who are known for their knowledge of dogs and the sport.
